School Safety and Security Committee Monday, August 3, 2020 7:30 P.M. Zoom Meeting

Call to Order

Senator Murphy-Bill on Police in Schools

Anthony Yorio stated that this was on the agenda as a point of conversation at the request of Maria Evans. Senator Murphy is championing a bill that defunds police in public schools and diverts all federal funds for police in schools to counseling for marginalized students to improve academic outcomes. His perspective is that this bill is trying to solve one problem by creating another. It also ignores the fact that some violence, such as Adam Lanza, is not from someone in the schools. He feels they should continue to have this conversation in the future.

Rich Sanzo stated that New Fairfield meets all of the mental health professional standards mentioned in the bill. He feels that the bill was just introduced and the Committee should monitor its progress in the future.

Anthony Yorio stated that the BOE should come together on their position and that each Board in town that has an opinion should write a position letter to Senator Murphy. He is vehemently against this.

Rick Regan stated that the bill is too blunt and doesn't seem like a solution.
