

WHEREAS, the Flash Track & Field Club finished a successful spring season this year after missing 2020 due to COVID; and,

WHEREAS, this season marks the Club's 20th year, founded in 2001 by town residents John Warrington, Janet Simons and Jim Keller; and,

WHEREAS, the Club has served about 1000 boys and girls from New Fairfield and Sherman as active members of the Flash Cross Country, Indoor Track or Spring Track programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Club has been among the most successful in the state, winning several state championships and helping to launch other clubs as well as the Western CT Conference; and,

WHEREAS, many Flash athletes have gone on to compete successfully for the New Fairfield High School Rebels Track & Field program; and,

WHEREAS, those same NFHS Rebels just completed their own historic winning season for both boys and girls; and,

WHEREAS, the Rebels were led for more than 25 years by former Rebel track star Tim Murphy; and,

WHEREAS, Coach Murphy also coached boys' and girls' cross country to several state titles and helped start the indoor track program; and,

WHEREAS, his oldest son, Timothy Jr., joined his father's team and became the greatest pole vaulter in CT history, still holding the state record of 16 feet, $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches; and,

WHEREAS, this year, Coach Murphy and T.J. will both be permanently enshrined onto the NFHS Athletic Wall of Fame; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, *I*, Patricia Del Monaco, First Selectman of the Town of New Fairfield, on behalf of the Board of Selectmen and the citizens of New Fairfield, do hereby express with great honor and pride that we declare Sunday, June 13, 2021 as honorary "Track Day" in New Fairfield.
