WHEREAS, JoAnn collaborated with colleagues to create the unique and successful program "Librarians after Dark", which inspired the launch of three successful, patron-led book clubs; and,

WHEREAS, patrons and colleagues will tell you that JoAnn was a natural working with children, loved her job, always had a smiling and welcoming face, was kind, was knowledgeable about book suggestions, and enthusiastic about making connections with children and adults alike; and,

WHEREAS, with all these wonderful contributions as well as countless story times, JoAnn would say her biggest accomplishment was connecting a child to the right book, which she hoped would spawn a love of reading. She took joy from being a source of support to parents navigating the struggles and triumphs of getting children excited about reading; and,

WHEREAS, JoAnn retired on June 1, 2021 after 23 years of exemplary service to the Library and to the Town of New Fairfield; and,
