*WHEREAS*, with all these wonderful contributions as well as countless story times, JoAnn would say her biggest accomplishment was connecting a child to the right book, which she hoped would spawn a love of reading. She took joy from being a source of support to parents navigating the struggles and triumphs of getting children excited about reading; and,

*WHEREAS*, JoAnn retired on June 1, 2021 after 23 years of exemplary service to the Library and to the Town of New Fairfield; and,

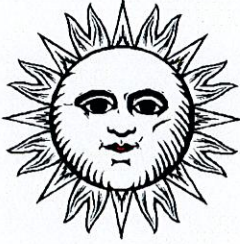
