### Call to Order

#### CELA scope reviews and additional packages recommended for award

Scott Pellman from Colliers showed a spreadsheet of everything that was awarded to date and information for recommended packages.

Mark Sedensky from O&G spoke of the scope of the CELA project that has received approval. He noted that demolition has been started on the project and parts of the project that will be recommended at this meeting. Specific awards include roofing, windows and storefront and flooring and painting. There was a discussion of bids received to date.

#### Truss alternate design for High School

Lorel Purcell from O&G Industries spoke of cost savings and the ability to meet schedule by using the Truss alternate design. She spoke of other projects that realized savings using this change. There was a consensus of the committee to go with the Truss alternate design.

# Materials Testing services for CELA

There was a consensus of the committee that everyone is in agreement with the Materials Testing services for the CELA project.

# <u>Update on Fire Tanks</u>

Christine O'Hare from JCJ gave an update on a meeting with the Fire Department regarding the fire tanks for the high school design. Once this design has been approved, the CELA project will follow the same design.

Mike Bouchard from Consulting Engineer Services spoke of the fire tanks including the style, size and sealing of the tanks. The tanks will be a little larger so that they can run for 75 minutes instead of 60 minutes. The change to 75 minutes would require another tank to the property. There was a brief discussion of whether or not the change to 75 minutes was necessary. Mike Gill from the Fire Department gave an explanation of the amount of water necessary for the fire tanks.

The design copies for the fire tanks will be sent to the Town Engineer and Fire Department.
