- 1. Call to order: Meeting called to order by chair Cynthia Ross-Zweig at 9:35am
- 2. **Minutes:** Walking on the property for the purpose of subdividing the lot of 10 acres on three separate lots.

The commissioners observed the property lines and locations of two new driveways on the map, provided by engineer Gallagher. Then, the commissioners observed the locations of two future houses, septic systems, and wells on the property. Ms. Ross-Zweig asked Mr. Gallagher about the water run off and neighboring properties. Mr. Gallagher stated, "There aren't any concerns or complaints from neighbors." Mr. Ernie Lehman mentioned about wetlands on the newly formed property, which is not impact by building the house. Engineer Gallagher also stated, "The builder is going to move the rock wall back into the property, giving away ten feet to the town, which is matching the new code for roads." The house is 75 set back from shortwoods road. Ms. Lisa Deldin pointed out that the proposed location of the house would be too close to a cliff, which raised a safety concern for future home owners. Cynthia Ross-Zweig and Ernie Lehman gave a recommendation to re-grade the left side of the property and to also move the location of the future house to the east and south. This involved moving the septic system as well.
