Discussion of the POCD and questionnaire for residents

The purpose of this special meeting was to discuss the proposed survey designed by the consultants Milone and MacBroom for residents regarding the Plan of Conservation and Development. This survey will be available to residents via "Survey Monkey". Chairman Cynthia Ross-Zweig will check

with the consultants to see about the possibility of paper copies of the survey for residents without computer access.

Specific questions for this survey include demographics such as age and education of residents and the number of years lived in New Fairfield. The survey will ask residents about their employment and commute to work. Residents will be asked about organizations that they are involved in and what first brought them to New Fairfield. There will be a section for full-time and seasonal residents.

There was a discussion among the commission members on how they can best "market" New Fairfield and what would attract residents. Specific suggestions for New Fairfield included a Recreation Center, more restaurants and possibly a farmer' market. There was a brief discussion of technology in the community and the economic development of New Fairfield.

There will be a Public Hearing on Saturday, October 5th from 10am to 12pm for residents to voice their opinions regarding the Plan of Conservation and Development. A postcard will be sent to residents informing them of the Public Hearing and encouraging them to take the survey via Survey Monkey. Chairman Cynthia Ross-Zweig will check into the venue for this meeting.
