OLD BUSINESS

Discussion on the 2003 Plan of Conservation and Development (C&D Plan)

The Commission discussed their role in implementing the C&D Plan. Many of the tasks are redundant and can either be combined or eliminated. The Commission discussed taking action for a scenic road ordinance and may look into using Sherman's scenic road ordinance as a guideline. Further discussion focused on how to address some of the issues in the Town Center, noting there aren't any laundries or car wash businesses because there isn't a sewer treatment facility. Danbury sewers run up to the Town line. Discussion followed. The Town Center would be more pedestrian friendly if businesses were located closer to the road with parking in the rear and sidewalks and pathways linking them together. A bike path may be constructed through the major arteries in Town. Lastly the Commission discussed the traffic pattern stating this is a bedroom community and in the morning the majority of traffic is leaving Town.
