

Re: Purchase of Marine 1 using Reserve Fund allotment

Dear Pat, Khris and Lori-Ann,

Thank you for placing the Department on the January 13<sup>th</sup> Board of Selectmen's agenda to hear our request to purchase a replacement for Marine 1, which was taken out of service by the Department a year ago and donated to the Candlewood Lake Authority. We are pleased that our donation was able to save the Town and the CLA money and that the boat is still providing productive service to the CLA. Our agreement with you at that time was that the replacement of Marine 1 would be moved up on the reserve fund replacement schedule to the current fiscal year.

To that end a Marine 1 Committee was appointed at the start of the fiscal year to determine the Department's needs for a replacement boat, review other boats on the Lake from our mutual aid partners, and develop specifications for the replacement boat. The Committee consisted of members from all three Companies, i.e. Assistant Chief Kristian Ebbesen as Chair, 1<sup>st</sup> Lt. Chris Gardner, AC Mike O'Toole, Capt. John Ransom, Jr., Doug Pfeiffer, and Bruce Kemble. The boat is a piece of Department apparatus, so the Department, not an individual Company, will pay the Department's share of the purchase price. Working with Patty Mota, the specifications developed for bid was a 22 foot, aluminum hull, drop deck boat, with no pump, much like the one Sherman purchased but with fewer options.

Three bids came back in late December, and the Committee recommended, and the Board of Directors approved the lowest of the three bids that met the specifications from Connor Industries, aka Stanley Boats. Attached is a one page description of the puts and takes on the bid as approved by the Board of Directors as well as a schematic of what the boat will look like. From order to delivery the build is expected to take almost 44 weeks.

As with the ambulance approved in November, the price of the materials in the boat, especially the aluminum, has gone up by almost 15% making the final cost, \$145,360.66. exceed the \$125,000 budgeted in the reserve fund. But, also like the ambulance purchase, given the Town's financial situation, the Fire Department is proposing to only take the original estimated 85% of \$125,000, or \$106,250 from the Reserve Fund, and to cover the remaining cost (not to exceed \$39,110.66) from its own funds that have been contributed over the years to help defray the cost of apparatus purchases.

Unfortunately, I am working the night of your meeting and cannot attend, but the members of the Marine 1 Committee will be there to make the presentation and to answer any questions you may have. Thank you for your consideration of our request.


