## Proposed use for 15/24 Pine Island, New Fairfield


Candlewood Fishing Camp is a non-profit camp that offers tuition assistance for families to send their kids to our program that focuses on fishing. Our camp increases the access, availability, and participation in fishing for kids 9-16 years of age. We believe all kids can enjoy the sport of fishing and benefit from a camp experience regardless of their family's financial situation. Fishing and camping are well known as a powerful outdoor therapy that reduces anxiety and depression. We are a tech free camp.

The land we leased the last three summers was sold and is no longer available for our use. The Pine Island property offers the same outdoor camping feel as the GS property did, with docks for boats and access on and off the island. Each lot will have a latrine and a compostable toilet, a pop-up shower tent with solar powered 5-gallon shower bags, only biodegradable soaps will be allowed on the island for use. All cold food will be stored in a large 60-gallon cooler with ice. All dinners will be delivered in trays from Johnny's and 440 Line in town. Poland Springs is a sponsor and will be supplying all of our water this summer in large 5 gallon jugs that will all be returned.

Candlewood Fishing Camp will run for four weeks June 19 – July 1 and July 31 – August 13. Each week is 6 days and 5 nights with full days only happening during the week Monday-Friday. Tents will be set up on the properties to accommodate 16 kids, 8 on each lot. The kids ages are 9-16 and are here to fish, make new friends and experience a tech free week away from home. They will be out on the water fishing with guides from 7 am – 1 pm and again from 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Campers are in bed with lights out by 9:30 pm each night. We are a small group of 16 kids per week. Our staff will stay on the island with a ratio of 4:1.

There will always be boats docked on the island ready to take kids back to the mainland for any potential emergencies. We will have cars accessible just one mile away.
