Proclamation Tom Quigley

WHEREAS, graduating with a degree in engineering, Tom entered the US Marine Corps serving 7 years active duty and 4 more years in the Reserves. He then worked as a pilot for TWA airlines, retiring after 34 years; and,

WHEREAS, moving to New Fairfield 34 years ago, he became the unofficial mayor to his neighbors on Sunswept Drive; and,

WHEREAS, Tom became active in local government when he was appointed to the Inland/Wetlands Commission in 2002. He now has been serving as Chairman of that Committee for several years, often leaving his summer home on Nantucket to attend meetings, as necessary; and,

WHEREAS, Tom also serves on the Water Pollution Control Authority as Chairman, and has actively led townwide water testing days to monitor and protect individual home water systems; and,

WHEREAS, once the town approved the water system to serve the then Shaw's market and shopping center, in addition to several businesses and town offices, Tom offered his expertise to manage the system. He took courses, receiving a state license and becoming certified to operate the system-which he did for over 20 years until the system was sold by town vote to Aquarion Water Co. He performed this service at no cost to the taxpayers; and,

WHEREAS, Tom has been married to his wife Janice for 42 years as of this month; they have a daughter, Katherine, and a son, Daniel, who with his wife, Chrissy, are the parents of Tom's grandson, Jack; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, *I*, Patricia Del Monaco, First Selectman of the Town of New Fairfield, on behalf of the Board of Selectmen and the citizens of New Fairfield, do hereby express our appreciation and gratitude to Tom Quigley, who is an example of someone who has given not only his time, but his special expertise to improve the quality of life in New Fairfield. He is indeed an active Senior member of our community. We extend our best wishes to Tom and thank him for all that he has done and continues to do for New Fairfield.
