Discussion of the Juneteenth Holiday

Pat Del Monaco noted that Juneteenth will officially become a Federal Holiday in 2023 but is being recognized as a State Holiday this year on June 20th. State offices and banks in Connecticut will be closed that day. There was a brief discussion of closing Town Hall to show support for this holiday.

ARPA Project review and approval process

Pat Del Monaco noted that the ARPA working group is getting very close to sending a recommendation to the BOS regarding the best uses of ARPA funds. They are still waiting for cost estimates for the renovation of Company A Firehouse. It is hopeful that this information will be available soon and the Selectmen can begin their process of reviewing the projects. It was noted that a possible addition to the list would be a new vault for the Town Clerk's office. There was a brief discussion of having a Town Meeting for the taxpayers to approve the uses of the ARPA funds once the review of the BOS is complete. There was a suggestion of having a Public Forum specifically inviting members of other town boards to discuss the plans.

DEEP suggested ordinance (Re: Feeding wild animals)

Pat Del Monaco noted that she received a call from a concerned citizen about residents feeding wild animals. Guidance from DEEP noted that the State Legislature is trying to pass a law that would regulate feeding wild animals in residential areas. There was a discussion of the possibility of the Town drafting an ordinance regarding the feeding of wild animals. This will be discussed further at the next BOS meeting.
