Special Town Meeting

The Special Town Meeting was called to order by First Selectman Pat Del Monaco at 6:30 p.m. After the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, the call of the meeting was read by Holly Z. Smith, Town Clerk. Craig Rosen made a motion to accept the call as read, seconded by Laurie Landa. Call passed unanimously by a voice vote.

Pat Del Monaco called for nominations for moderator. Rick Regan nominated Tom Quigley, seconded by Craig Rosen. Hearing no further nominations, Pat Del Monaco called for Tom Quigley to be moderator. Call passed unanimously by voice vote. Pat Del Monaco declared Tom Quigley moderator.

Moderator Quigley read Resolution #1 and #2 and stated they would be removed for submission to the voters by machine vote at such date and time as may be determined:

Resolution #1:

To consider and act upon the appropriation of Town Government Expenditures totaling \$13,265,589 from the General Fund, and \$788,239 from the Capital and Non-Recurring Fund, and \$799,502 from other Governmental Funds, as recommended by the Board of Finance, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023.

Resolution #1:

To consider and act the appropriation of Education Expenditures totaling \$48,236,562 from the General Fund, and \$93,885 from the Capital and Non-Recurring Fund, as recommended by the Board of Finance, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023.

Moderator Quigley asked for a motion to set the date and time for the machine vote. Wes Marsh made a motion to hold the vote on Saturday, May 14, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m., seconded by Robert Kruzykowski. Moderator Quigley called for discussion on the motion. After hearing no discussion, Moderator Quigley called for a vote to set the date and time for the machine vote to be Saturday, May 14, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. Motion approved unanimously.


Paul Gouvia made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Wes Marsh; approved unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
