

Veterans must file their DD214 (discharge papers) with the Town Clerks Office by October 1st to receive the basic exemption on your property tax on the following July bill. This is a \$6,000 assessment exemption, meaning your assessment is lowered by \$6,000. The Veteran must have been honorably discharged and have served during an active war period. There is no application for this exemption and the exemption stays on the house until it is sold or no longer in the Veterans name or his/her spouse. The exemption is increased if the Veteran has a VA disability. We ask that you bring your letter from the VA indicating your percent disability at the time you file your DD214.
