Housing Opportunities Committee Report

Pat Del Monaco welcomed Anita Brown, Kathleen DiTullio and Kathy Hull from the Housing Opportunities Committee.

Housing Opportunities Committee Chairman Anita Brown spoke of purpose and role of the committee. This presentation included an Introduction, an assessment of current housing needs, land use and zoning assessments and goals and strategies. She spoke of statistics of New Fairfield residents and showed income and demographics of who would qualify for affordable housing. The committee will give this presentation to the Planning Commission and Zoning Commission. A survey was made available to New Fairfield residents and received 447 responses. There was a brief discussion of the timeline for implementation of affordable housing and the next steps in the process.

Consider Draft Sex Offender Ordinance

Pat Del Monaco noted that a Public Hearing was held on July 27th to discuss proposed changes to the Sex Offender Ordinance. These changes include changing "Child Sex Offender" to simply "Sex Offender" and including the library in the definition of the "Child Safety Zone". A document listing the "Child Safety Zones" will be made available by the Town of New Fairfield. The next step is for the BOS to vote on this ordinance and then send it to a Town Meeting.

Discussion and Vote on changes to LOSAP

Pat Del Monaco spoke of a procedure for service awards for LOSAP (Length of Service Award Program) for the volunteer firefighters in the event that a participant becomes disabled. She thanked Town Treasurer Terry Friedman and Finance Director Olga Melnikov for their help in compiling this procedure.
