Security Camera Proposal – Mark Schweitzer reviewed the Stanely Security proposal for the new High School. The proposal included the installation of the old security cameras salvaged from the old high school, as well as new cameras required for the new site. There was a discussion about the need for a new server. Paul Gouveia explained to the PBC why a new server was likely not needed.
