Since we last emailed, we have had our initial meeting with the ZBA board and I would like to bring you up to date. Subsequent to the meeting we have, scaled back our proposal to eliminate the sightline issues. To achieve this we are taking the chimney down and changing the roofline on the side of the house that faces South, so that the roof slopes in that direction above the original first floor. We do not require any setback variance on the rear of our property as that has always been and continues to be within zoning regulations. The height of the roof will have no impact on sightlines from your property.

We appreciate that you have always been good neighbors and that we have always dealt with issues on our mutual property boundaries amicably.
