Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Town of New Fairfield and those qualified to vote at a Town Meeting to be held on Tuesday, September 17, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. at the Senior Center at 33 Route 37, New Fairfield, CT for the following purposes.

1. To consider and act upon the expenditure of American Rescue Plan Funds of \$1,094,143 on:

Ball Pond Watershed Stormwater Drainage / Arden Avenue, Merlin Avenue and Orehill Road Phase 1, Candlewood Corners Drainage Repairs, Bear Mountain Bridge Safety Improvements, Senior Center Dam Study, Town Hall Parking Lot Drainage, Company A Firehouse Split System, Company A Firehouse Siding, Company A Firehouse Roof, Company A Firehouse Soffit Replacement, Squantz Pond Firehouse Air Conditioning Replacement, Senior Center Exterior Doors, ARPA Voting Expenses and High School Track and Turf Field Replacement.

2. To consider and authorize an Additional Appropriation to transfer \$520,407 from General Fund – Unreserved to Board of Education Capital and Non-Recurring Fund for the purpose of replacing the New Fairfield Stadium Turf and Track.
