Presentation of the Board of Education Requested Budget 2010/2011

Superintendent of Schools Dr. Joseph Castagnola presented the Board of Education requested budget for 2010/2011 and gave a power point presentation. The total BOE's requested budget for 2010/2011 equals \$36,756,796 for a 4.16% increase over the 2009/2010 budget. This percentage represents a dollar amount increase of \$1,468,282. Dr. Castagnola spoke of contractural obligations and noted that the 4.16% increase was due to debt service attached to the school building project. There was also a discussion of oil prices and health insurance as well as GASB 45.

Dr. Castagnola noted that this was his last budget process as superintendent and thanked the Town of New Fairfield for allowing him to serve as superintendent. Dr. Castagnola thanked all the teachers, administrators and the Board of Finance for all their help with the budget. Dr. Castagnola especially thanked Town of New Fairfield Accounting Manager Ed Sbordone for his hard work and for filling in during School Business Manager Craig McClain's absence.
