One of the pervasive problems on Candlewood Lake has been the increase in past years of Eurasian Milfoil. To decrease its growth and keep the lake open for boating and swimming, FirstLight has done deep drawdowns in alternating years. Three years ago, CLA started introducing sterile grass carp, which feed on the milfoil.

In order to understand what is effective in keeping the growth of milfoil down, Greg Bugbee, a scientist with the Connecticut Agricultural Extension Station has worked with CLA to map the yearly fluctuations in weed growth. He has done this using a specific methodology since 2007. Last year, FirstLight opted to switch vendors and chose to ask George Knoecklein to do the weed mapping. Knoecklein has long been FirstLight's consultant and two years ago was a strong advocate for using chemicals in the Lake to control the milfoil.

To make sure that the established scientific methodology is maintained to ensure scientific validity and to ensure that the objectivity that The Agricultural Extension Service brings to the table continues, we are proposing that the Towns surrounding Candlewood Lake, along with CLA hire Greg Bugbee and the CAES to continue to study and report on the extent of milfoil and other invasive aquatic species in Wandlewood Lake. The cost of the study is \$2000.
