Old Business:

- Town Park
 - Cynthia Stevens provided Brian Bosley with a copy of the most recent proposal from Didona and Associates with the financials listed.
 - Cynthia Stevens reiterated that she made an application to the Community Trust via Dana Welles who has forwarded it on to several potential donors. Ms. Welles has yet to hear back from any of them.
 - Cynthia Stevens reported that, at a recent Friends of Ball Pond meeting, there was talk of volunteers taking on the project. Discussion of the BPAC ensued. The consensus is that the project should be overseen by professionals for a number of reasons.
- Carp restocking
 - George Benson has not submitted his report to date. Since this report is critical for making the case for additional carp, the process of moving from raw data to a report needs to be tightened up going forward. In the future, the Chair of the BPAC will send the water quality data from Hydro Technologies to George Benson. Then s/he will follow up with Tim Simpkins to make sure that he has sent all of his necessary data to George Benson and, finally, with George Benson to ensure that he has received everything.

New Business:

- Water Lilies
 - Brian Bosley raised the issue of the need to come up with a more effective plan for dealing with pink water lily removal this year. He will research some possibilities (including benthic barriers) and requested that this be an agenda item at a future meeting.

- Ice Fishing
 - Helen Gallagher remarked that there seem to be more people ice fishing this year than in the past. There was some concern about people using gas augers, but it seems that most are using manual models.
