The total of these cuts is \$507,577 resulting in a BOS recommended budget for 2012/2013 of \$8,557,395 which represents an increase from the 2011-2012 budget of \$196,058 or 2.34%. It was noted that this proposed budget has not yet been voted on by the Selectmen and it will be discussed further at their January 26, 2012 regular meeting.
