### **Discussion and vote on Police Vehicles**

After a trade in the cost for the two vehicles would be \$46,648.00. There is also a cost for additional add-ons. There is an information packet describing these vehicles that will be presented to the BOF at their September 18<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Susan Chapman made a motion to approve the Year-End Intra-Departmental Transfers for a total amount of \$78,996.90. Mike Gill seconded the motion. (Such document to be attached to the minutes of this meeting).

There was a discussion of the cost of resident state troopers and how much the town pays of their salaries. There was a brief discussion of the resident state trooper cars and depreciation. Ed Sbordone will check to see what year the trooper cars are.

There was a discussion of the Inter-Departmental transfers and it was noted that expenses for the recent storms were funded from the town's budget but any reimbursements received will go towards the surplus.
