Vote to purchase ambulance for the Fire Department

Fire Chief Jim Gardner spoke of the purchase of an ambulance for New Fairfield Fire Dept. This would replace the 2002 Ford ambulance that the department presently owns. The approximate cost of this type of ambulance is \$206,000 to \$214,000 but, the fire department was able to get the price down to \$185,000. The cost of this ambulance will be split 75% from the town budget (\$138,000) and 25% from the Fire Department (\$46,250). The old ambulance will be sold with 75% of the proceeds going to the town and 25% of the proceeds going to Squantz Engine Company. It will take approximately 180 days to get the ambulance.

Susan Chapman made a motion to approve the purchase of an ambulance at a cost not to exceed \$185,000 with a draw on the Reserve fund of \$138,750 and a contribution of up to \$46,250 from the New Fairfield Volunteer Fire Department. Mike Gill seconded the motion.
