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<u>Discuss and vote to authorize the First Selectman to sign the Certified Local Government Grant</u> <u>application for the Creamery</u>

Gerry Bielizna and Faline Schneiderman of the Historic Properties Commission noted that the Historic Properties Commission has filled out the paperwork to apply for a grant through the Certified Local Government program through the Department of Economic and Community Development. Such grant would be used to determine the structural soundness of the foundation and framework of the Creamery. The amount of this grant is approximately \$10,000. There was a discussion of putting an RFP out for determination for technical and soundness study.

Donation to Social Services

Donation for Pavilion at Rebel Turf

Fred Testor from the Parks and Recreation Commission spoke of donations that were made to put supplemental heat in the Pavilion at Rebel Turf. This heat would be used solely to keep pipes and equipment from freezing and would cost approximately \$8,000. The Booster Club has donated \$3,000 towards this project and the Lacrosse and Soccer Clubs have donated \$1,000 each. The New Fairfield Parks and Recreation Commission will provide the additional \$3,000. Mr. Testor spoke of the electric bills and noted that in the case of significant electric bills, Parks and Rec will contribute to this.

Susan Chapman made a motion to accept donations in the total amount of \$4,000 from the Rebel Booster Club (\$3,000) and the Lacrosse Club (\$1,000). Mike Gill seconded the motion. **Vote: 3-0-0 (Motion approved)**
