Discussion and vote to approve proposed Board of Selectmen 2016-2017 budget

Susan Chapman made a motion to approve the Board of Selectmen 2016-2017 budget as presented. Mike Gill seconded the motion.

The board discussed the 2016-2017 BOS budget and noted that it totals \$11,161,734.00 which represents an overall increase of 5.56% over the 2015-2016 budget. This amount is inclusive of the Capital and Nonrecurring budget. It was noted that the original proposed BOS budget represented an increase of over 13% but with many cuts it was brought down to 5.56%. It was noted that this increase also includes adjustments necessary due to the increase in the State Police costs.

The budget will be presented to the Board of Finance on Saturday, March 5th.
