#### **Budget Workshop schedule and discussion**

The next budget workshop is scheduled for Wednesday, January 31<sup>st</sup> at 10:30am in the Town Hall Conference Room. First Selectman Del Monaco noted that the BOS has met with all the departments and will now be discussing the budget as a whole. There was a brief discussion of the challenges of the budget and items that will be put in this year that were cut from last year's budget. Anyone interested in the budget process is encouraged to attend the January 31<sup>st</sup> meeting.

#### Selectmen Facebook Page

First Selectman Pat Del Monaco spoke of the Town's Facebook page and noted that the intention of the Facebook page is to post town events, meetings, information messages and ALERT Now messages. She and the New Fairfield IT department will be administrators for this page. The Administrative Assistant in the Selectmen's office will post links to agendas, minutes and meeting videos. Comments will be permitted but the Town will not respond to comments. Residents are encouraged to use the "Contact Us" section on the Town's website for comments or questions. First Selectman Del Monaco thanked John McCartney for all his help with putting this page together. Selectman Kim Hanson spoke of the challenges of having many pages on a Facebook page and suggested a social media page on the website.

Khris Hall made a motion to approve creating a Town of New Fairfield Facebook page. Pat Del Monaco seconded the motion.

#### Lock in of fuel rates for the fiscal year July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019

Khris Hall made a motion to allow the First Selectman to lock in fuel rates for the fiscal year July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Kim Hanson seconded the motion.

Finance Director Ed Sbordone spoke of the price of fuel oil and noted that it is possible to lock in a partial amount if interested. Selectman Kim Hanson asked First Selectman Del Monaco to inform the BOS if the price is higher than what is budgeted for.

Pat Del Monaco spoke of the fee structure for the Drop off center and the drop in revenues from the year 2012 to 2013. This was due mostly to the restructuring of recyclables. Selectmen Kim Hanson asked for more information about revenues and comparisons of prices for surrounding towns. Finance Director Ed Sbordone spoke of a meeting with town officials to determine the increase in prices.
