Dr. Sanzo noted that some of the equipment for this project could possibly be repurposed if the school projects are approved at referendum.

Discussion and vote to approve creation of HRRA Household Hazardous Waste Fund

Selectman Kim Hanson spoke of a proposal by HRRA Executive Director Jennifer Heaton-Jones to have all of the participating towns contribute to the registration funds to go towards funding three extra Household Hazardous Waste Days a year. He spoke of his concerns that none of the extra Household Hazardous Waste Days are located in Danbury and whether or not a lot New Fairfield residents would participate. There was a suggestion of possibly having a Hazardous Waste Day in New Fairfield.

HRRA Assistant Tiffany Carlson spoke of the purpose of this fund and noted that residents would have six Household Hazardous Waste Days instead of the current two. Selectman Kim Hanson suggested trying this for one year and reviewing the cost benefits.

Kim Hanson made a motion to officially confirm to HRRA that they can withhold the registrations fees for New Fairfield for the next year for the purpose of creating a household hazardous waste fund. Pat Del Monaco seconded the motion. **Vote: 3-0-0 (Motion approved)**
