- c. Long Range Plan Sean Loughran reviewed and summarized the suggestions submitted by the members. The members discussed how the playground continues to require a lot of work. More detailed cost estimates and information is needed from John Hodge on any other funds that may be available related to the beach house. - **b. Fall events staffing** Volunteer roles for the Turkey Run and Tree Lighting were reviewed.
- **c. Programming** Linda Lull reported that the pre-registration numbers for the Turkey Run are higher than expected. Therefore, additional shirts have been ordered.
- **d.** Review of Fees Tabled for future discussion. There was a suggestion to implement a family maximum for swim lessons.

6. Subcommittee Reports

- a. Waterfront Steve Merullo had received some estimates for extending the kick boards at the beach swim team platforms an extra 12 inches, further information is needed regarding requirements and verification of costs. The commission discussed purchasing jet ski floats and charging approximately \$750 to rent the slips. Parks & Recreation would use the dock fund to pay for these. The Commission reviewed beach house plans and put together a list of issues.
