**Update on Grant Applications:** R. Sanzo reported that he applied for the School Security Competitive Grant Round 4 in December. He followed up with DEMHS and expects a response in late March or early April. A. Yorio requested that Mr. Sanzo update the group on the availability of the Interoperability Grant established in last year's legislative session.

**Anonymous Reporting System Launch:** R. Sanzo reported that the "Say Something" program will be launched in late April. The next step is training for students which will be completed before spring break, and the program will launch immediately after training is completed.

**School Security Mater Plan (public session):** R. Sanzo reported that he is compiling the results from the audits conducted by NSC, CIRMA and DEMHS to prepare a School Security Master Plan. The Plan will address Preparation, Mitigation, Response and Recovery from school emergencies. Once the plan is completed, training plans for each school and staff will be developed and implemented.
