- Noise emitted repeatedly from a specific motor vehicle, including motorcycles and boats, that is not muffled to meet standard practices and is emitted in a manner that a reasonable person would conclude disturbs the right of residents to the peaceful enjoyment of their home.
- Noise from lawn, garden, and tree trimming operations before the hours of XXX and after the hours of YYY.
- Noise from commercial operations before the hours of XXX and after the hours of YYY.
