Call to Order:

High School Culinary Arts Project-

We bid out the project and unfortunately did not receive an offer from any general contractor. A bid was received by a mechanical contractor, solely for the mechanical portion of the project. A final number is currently being waited on from this contractor. There is a potential way to save money on flooring by switching the tile type from khoury to VCT. The problem with the mechanical job, however, is that it will not be under 100k. Paying prevailing wage is about 30% more money than without it. At this point the 400k budget will probably not be sufficient. Phil will then talk to Dr. Roy in reference to adding more money on to the budget possibly. If the funds are unavailable or the schedule is changed the project will have to be put off for another year. The estimated budget is from 400k to 600k total. All of the money will be taken from the school budget, not the town budget. Any project under 100k has to pay prevailing wages to its employees. A local vendor in Danbury offered to the job for a little over 200k. Phil buying his own equipment for the job would cost roughly 80k, additionally saving a rough 30k. Measurements and surveys were already put into place for this project. All building plans will be sent to and payed to Joseph Merritt and cost \$125. We have our own plumbers but we will be hiring a new mechanic in the process. Using Phil's own plumbre would cut costs significantly at \$70 an hour.

Library Project-

The renovation on the doors will be performed by Advanced construction. The elevators are not to be renovated
