For vehicles sold, stolen, totaled and the registration was NOT transferred to another vehicle, or IF YOU HAVE MOVED OUT OF STATE, you may also be eligible for a tax credit. To obtain a credit, you must furnish proof as required by the assessor. All forms of proof must specifically identify the vehicle. Any ONE of the following may be furnished, IN ADDITION TO A PLATE RECIEPT:

- 1. SALE: A copy of the bill of sale (must show vehicle and buyers name and date sold
- 2. TRADE IN: copy of the purchase agreement identifying trade in vehicle.
- 3. TOTALLED VEHICLE: Insurance company settlement statement showing date of loss
- 4. JUNKED: Dated statement from junk dealer.
- 5. STOLEN?NOT RECOVERED: Statement from insurance company or police report
- 6. OUT OF STATE: Copy of motor vehicle registration from another state
