# Candlewood Lake Authority New Patrol Boats

Preserving and Protecting Candlewood Lake Since 1972 Brookfield - Danbury - New Fairfield - New Milford - Sherman

### Why Are We Here?

- 1. CLA is responsible for public safety on Candlewood Lake
- 2. CLA lost 2 patrol boats in summer of 2020 due to COVID
- 3. We need commercial purpose vessels rather than modified recreational boats.
- 4. Commercial purpose vessels must be ordered by end of October for May delivery
- 5. The 2020/2021 CLA budget requires a special appropriation now, outside of budget cycle, to provide adequate public safety and address health and sanitation issues on the lake in 2021



### Candlewood Lake

Largest Lake in Connecticut: 65 miles of shoreline, 5420 acres

Waterfront Residences: Approx. 1,600

Draws thousands of visitors annually

Over 150 fishing tournaments / year

**Shoreline Municipalities:** Towns of Brookfield, New Fairfield, New Milford, Sherman and the City of Danbury



### Candlewood Lake Authority

- Formed in 1972 out of a Need for Public Safety and Law Enforcement on the Lake
- Environmental Protection and Education Added a Few Years Later When Water Quality Declines
- Empowered By *CT General Statute 7-151a* to Act as an Agent of the 5 towns
- 5 Towns established to "Pay to the Lake Authority its respective share of expenses of the CLA" split evenly between the 5.
  - CLA Supplements this Through Fundraising activities
  - FirstLight Contributes Annually as a Donation



## Candlewood's Changing Identity

This year solidified that we are not currently equipped to handle the challenges of Candlewood's changing identity:

- Unprecedented crowding
- Island overuse
- Extreme boat traffic
- Growing concerns for noise and resident safety

Our current resources are also spread to environmental concerns:

- Discovery of a zebra mussel in Candlewood
- Pollution and erosion of islands due to increased use
- Water quality preservation



### Role of CLA Marine Patrol

#### The CLA Marine Patrol enforces CT boating law.

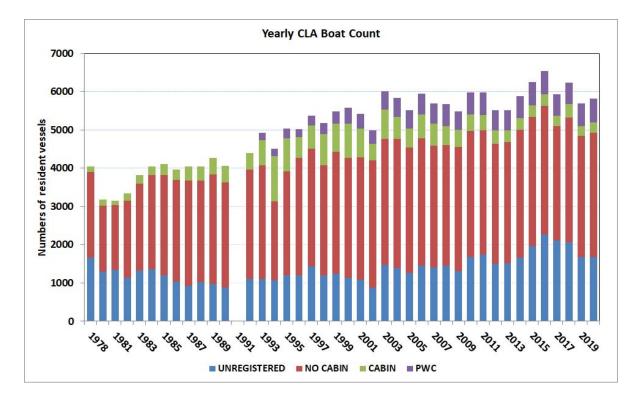
- Educate Boaters on Safe Boating
- Respond to Accidents; Often 1st on Scene
- Perform Vessel Safety Checks
- Assist Disabled Watercraft
- Assist law enforcement, fire and EMS units
- Collaborate with DEEP on special operations
- Remove hazardous debris



### CLA Annual Resident Boat Count

Since 2017, the resident boat count has shown:

- Registered Boat w/o cabins increased by 8% (2994 → 3240)
- Registered Boat w/ cabin increased by 2% (269 → 274)
- PWCs have increased by 11% (553  $\rightarrow$  620)

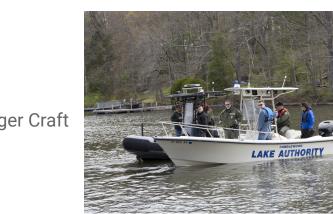

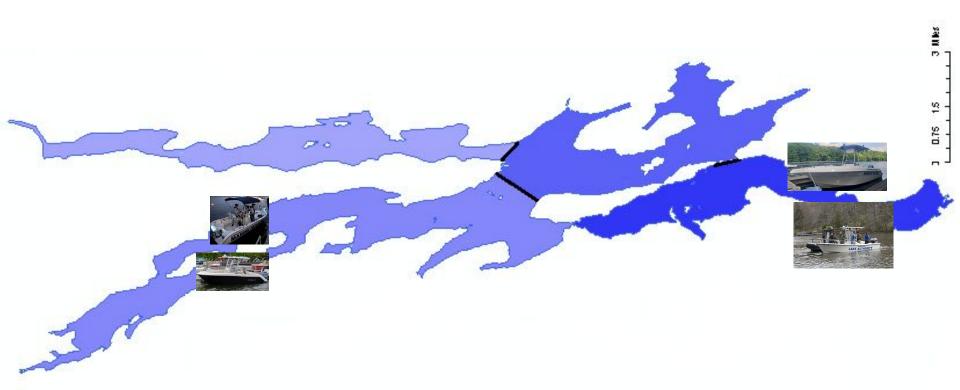

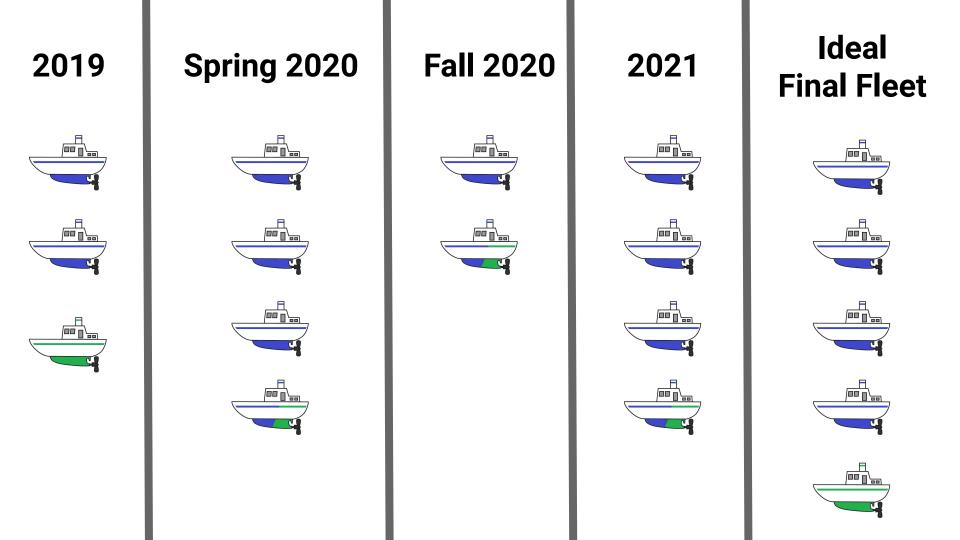

# Looking Forward

- Increased lake usage has resulted in more traffic, noise and health and safety issues on the islands.
- The CLA has only 2 operating boats
- The <u>first</u> step to addressing all these issues is ensuring an adequate number of patrols on the lake.
- For 2021, we are asking for 2 new patrol boats to replace the 2 that were lost in 2020
  - We will continue to use the environmental work boat as dual purpose until a 3rd new patrol boat can be purchased to complete a 4 patrol boat force

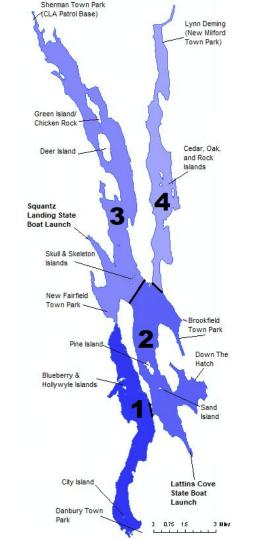




### New Vessel Impact

- Position vessels in high density areas
- Address noise issues before they happen, educate
- Maintain presence/visibility within each town boundary rotating vessels every two hours
- Patrol vessel visibility by default will curtail behavior which is affecting towns and local recreational lake users

Two vessels are not enough to service the entire body of water



### Patrol Capabilities with New Vessels

- Ability to run periodic special operations
- Establish Checkpoints for safety checks
- Inform vessel occupants of island restrictions
- Terminate voyage for safety violations, overloaded conditions etc.
- Lattins Cove, Danbury Boat Launch, NF Squantz Launch, Skull Island, Blueberry Island

### In Summary

To ensure Public Health and Safety on Candlewood in 2021 and beyond, 4 patrol boats must be on the water on weekends and holidays.

2 new patrol boats need to be purchased at a cost of \$150,000 each and Ordered by October 31 to ensure Spring delivery. Cost per town \$60,000.

The CLA is asking for an emergency appropriation for an unanticipated expense in this budget year needed to cover the cost of replacing 2 lake safety marine patrol boats that have been taken out of service.

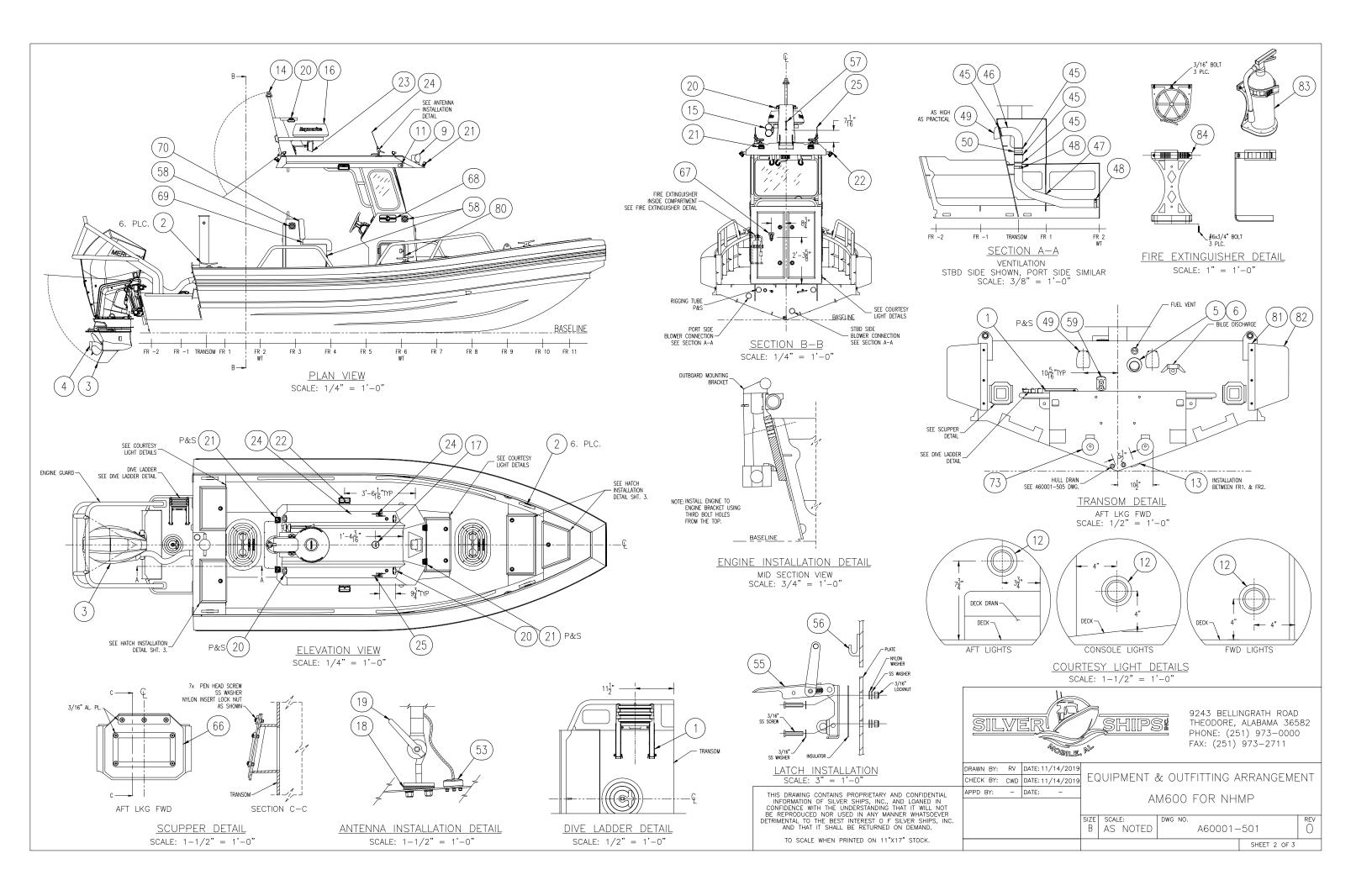

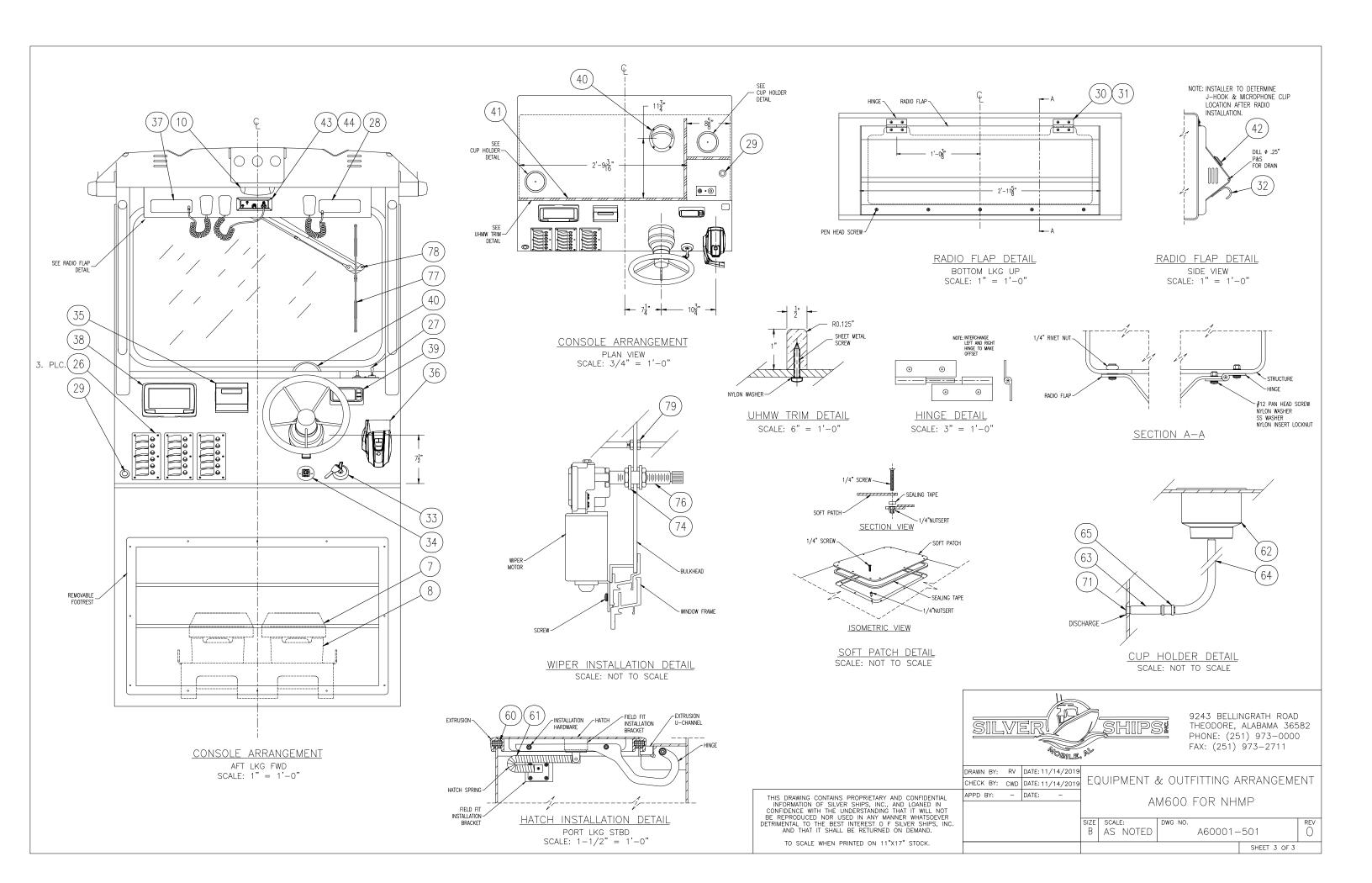

**OVERVIEW:** The following describes a 23' PackMan welded aluminum high speed landing craft 2021 production model. The crafts' design and construction (hull, machinery, and electrical systems) shall comply with the USCG and ABYC regulations where applicable. Detailed drawings will be submitted for approval prior to construction. Boat shall exit the factory as a completed vessel, adhering to the following specifications.

#### **GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Hull Length: 23 feet
- 2. Beam: 8.5 feet
- 3. Transom Deadrise: 16 degrees
- 4. Person and Cargo Capacity: 2500 lbs
- 5. Propulsion: Single 250hp Yamaha Four Stroke Outboard Motor
- 6. Fuel Capacity: 75 gallons
- 7. Bow Door Clearance: 64 inches
- 8. Bottom Plating: 1/4 inch 5086-H116
- 9. Side Plating: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inch 5052-H32
- 10. Deck Plating: 3/16 inch 5052-H32
- 11. Centerline Vertical Keel (CVK): 3/8" x 4" 6061

#### **HULL PACKAGE:**

23' PackMan modified vee hull landing craft incorporating a 64" wide bow door.

Hull shall include two structural bulkheads; the forward collision bulk head shall be watertight, the aft bulkhead shall be limbered for drainage via bilge pump.

8" welded aluminum inspection hatches shall be installed to provide access to all below deck compartments.

Six (6) 10" welded aluminum cleats shall be installed. (3 Per Side)

A <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" aluminum double padeye shall be welded on centerline of the bow.

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" rolled plate, 7" radius bow corners shall be installed on the port and starboard sides of the bow door opening.

The transom shall be setup for outboard power and set at 103 degrees off baseline for proper outboard trim

The motor well shall be self-bailing via two 2.5" pipe drains running out through transom. Drains shall be equipped with rubber flappers to divert water from entering slop well when operating the boat in reverse.

The stern shall incorporate port and starboard corner rigging lockers, framing the motor well. Lockers will house batteries and fuel filter systems, and offer general storage. Both lockers will be outfitted with 3/16" welded aluminum weatherproof hatches with 1-1/2" angle aluminum frame, key lockable 316 series Stainless Steel "T" handle latches, welded 100mm aluminum hinges with grease fitting and Stainless Steel pins, and 1/8" thick PORON neoprene hatch seal.

316 Series Stainless Steel fastening hardware shall be used throughout the vessel.

The hull shall incorporate a 2" pipe gunnel.

#### WELDING:

The hull and superstructure shall be constructed of marine grade aluminum and MIG welded throughout.

All weld seams in the hull shall be welded 100%, both interior & exterior.

All welding shall be performed in accordance with American Welding Society D1.2-2003 procedure qualifications.

All surface areas shall be shiny, mill finish, with no grind marks, splatters, or blemishes.

#### **HULL OUTFITTING:**

 $1\frac{1}{4}$ " Sch 40 pipe safety railings shall be installed 32" above main deck along port & stbd sides from stern to midship.

One (1)  $1/4" \times 4"$  Beaching wear plate shall be installed on the bow forefoot.

One (1) 26" wide side door shall be installed. Door shall swing inboard and forward in direction, and lock in the closed position.

Four (4) Open scuppers installed flush with the deck at midship and two (2) large pipe drains in the stern shall create a self-bailing main deck. Drains and scuppers shall be sized and installed in accordance with ABYC deck drainage requirements.

One (1) Set of tie down rails shall be installed. Tie down rails consist of 1.25" sch 40 pipe installed above the main deck on port and starboard sides with 4" of clearance below the pipe.

Two (2) Mini Diver Dream, 2.25 lb. zinc anodes, shall be installed on brackets that are welded to the transom.

#### **BOW DOOR OUTFITTING:**

A 64 inch wide drop down bow door shall be installed to enable personnel transport.

The hull shall incorporate port and starboard bow lockers framing the door opening.

A 12v Warn VRX-25 winch spooled with synthetic line shall be installed for opening and closing the bow door.

The winch cable runs through stainless steel cheek pulleys on each side of the door providing equal tension on both sides when opened and closed.

The bow door shall be outfitted with two (2)  $\frac{3}{4}$ " stainless steel positive locking pin to prevent the bow door from opening while underway.

A replaceable rubber gasket seals the bow door watertight when closed.

The inside face of the bow door shall be double plated for a smooth working surface.

Switches to operate the bow door shall be installed locally and at the main console.

#### **FUEL SYSTEM:**

A 75 gallon non-integral fuel tank shall be installed complete with fill, vent, 12V sender and fuel level gauge on console. Fuel tank shall be built from 1/4" plate, pressure tested to 4 psi and bolted into hull framing using doublers and stainless steel fasteners.

One (1) fuel filter/water separator shall be installed complete with shut off valve.

Fuel system shall comply with U.S. diurnal emission standards.

12V 140 CFM bilge blower installed in fuel tank compartment.

#### **CONSOLE:**

A 52" wide console T-top shall be installed aft on centerline with 60" wide x 120" long roof.

T-top includes four (4) fixed windows with aft leaning windshields, an overhead radio bar, angled aluminum control console, and a flush mounted bolt on console access panel on the forward side of the console for ease of maintenance and future upgrades.

The aft side of the console shall include 3/16" welded aluminum weatherproof hatches with 1 -1/2" angle aluminum frame, key lockable 316 series Stainless Steel "T" handle latches, welded 100mm aluminum hinges with grease fitting and Stainless Steel pins, and 1/8" thick PORON neoprene hatch seal.

A lockable radio box shall be installed at the console.

The T-top roof shall incorporate 1" pipe roof railings, and vertical grab rails on port and starboard sides.

One (1) Cup holder shall be installed at the console.

A removable canvas enclosure shall be supplied to protect the pilot station.

Pipe ladder rungs shall be incorporated into the aft T-top Supports to provide access to the roof.

Two (2) Bentley Tandem Patriot extra wide captain seats shall be installed under the T-top on welded aluminum seat boxes. Each seat incorporates a stationary arm, backrest and footrest. Welded aluminum access hatches shall be installed to provide access to the seat box storage compartment. Seat slides shall be installed when applicable to supply 7-1/2" of horizontal adjustment.

One (1) Exterior storage locker shall be installed on the front of the console. The locker storage compartment is accessed through 3/16" welded aluminum weatherproof hatches with 1-1/2" angle aluminum frame, 316 series stainless steel "T" handle latches, welded 100mm aluminum hinges with grease fitting and stainless steel pins, and 1/8" thick PORON neoprene hatch seal.

#### **HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING:**

A Webasto AT2000 forced air diesel fired cabin heater rated for 7,000 BTU's shall be installed complete with thermostat and outlets for windshield defrost and cabin heat. Fuel to be supplied by a 5 gallon diesel tank.

#### DAVIT:

A socket for a 3" pipe davit shall be installed on the vessel. (socket only – no davit)

A Warn DC800 lifting hoist shall be installed on the davit. The hoist shall be operated via a local up/down switch and spooled with 50' of 3/16" Amsteel line.

#### **ANCHORING:**

Vessel will include an anchor package consisting of one (1) 13lb Rocna anchor, 15' of 5/16" galvanized chain and 100' of 9/16" 3-strand Proset anchor line.

Proper storage for the anchor shall be provided.

An anchor pulpit shall be installed on the vessel complete with a 12v Lewmar 1000 anchor windlass. Anchor shall be secured in the "up" position by a pin or chain tensioner (dependent on space and application). Pulpit shall have 1/2" bull horns to prevent the anchor rode from slipping off the roller.

#### **TOWING:**

A 3" Sch 80 aluminum pipe tow bit with 1" 316 stainless crucifix pin shall be installed aft on

centerline. The towing bit shall be sized to accept one round turn and three figure eight's of the towline.

#### **STERN GUARDS AND PLATFORMS:**

A fixed aluminum guard made from 2" aluminum pipe shall be welded to the transom to protect the outboard motor.

Small welded aluminum swim step with non-skid shall be installed on the port and starboard sides of the transom.

#### TRIM TABS:

9" x 12" Bennett hydraulic-actuated trim tabs shall be installed.

#### **ELECTRICAL SYSTEM:**

The vessel's electrical system shall be 12vDC.

All electrical cable shall be marine grade copper tinned boat cable and labeled for each circuit.

Cables should be routed in wireways wherever possible. Wherever exposed to potential damage, cables shall be protected with rubber.

Electrical cable shall be sized in accordance with the American Boat & Yacht Council.

All electrical cables shall be marked in accordance with the markings in electrical drawings.

All electrical switches shall be of a heavy-duty type and properly insulated.

The electrical system shall be grounded. In any case the hull shall not be used as part of a galvanic feeding loop.

#### **12V DC ACCESSORIES:**

One (1) 12V 6 position waterproof distribution panel shall be installed on the console.

One (1) Pair of 12V self-parking windshield wipers shall be installed on the forward windshields. Each wiper assembly consists of a fully sealed, marine rated wiper motor fitted with a heavy duty pantographic wiper arm and matching blade.

One (1) 12V air trumpet horn shall be installed with momentary push button on dash.

One (1) 12V power receptacle with weather cover shall be installed.

One (1) Dual USB outlet shall be installed in the vessel, this outlet enables the charging of USB devices.

One (1) Raw water wash down pump system shall be installed complete with spigot, 25' hose coil, and nozzle. Storage for the hose coil shall be supplied. Pump is a 6.0 gpm Johnson "HotShot" or equivalent.

One (1) 12V 2200 GPH bilge pump shall be installed with auto float switch.

#### LIGHTING:

LED navigation lights shall be installed to USCG requirements.

One (1) 12V LED red/white dome light shall be installed over the operator.

Two (2) Rigid Industries M-Series dually LED Flood lights shall be installed on the T-top roof.

One (1) Whelen Century 23" LED blue light bar shall be installed on the T-top roof. Controls for the light bar shall be installed at the console.

#### **NAVIGATION ELECTRONICS:**

A Garmin 1042xsv - 10" screen GPS Plotter/Sounder shall be installed on the vessel. This includes local area maps, GPS antenna, transom mounted transducer, and installation.

A Garmin VHF 210 Marine Radio shall be installed complete with Shakespeare antenna and Sea Dog Lily mount.

A Whelen WPA1 siren system with 100W speaker horn shall be installed on the vessel. The system controller and microphone shall be installed at the console.

#### **OUTFITTING AND SAFETY EQUIPMENT:**

A carbon monoxide detector shall be mounted in the wheelhouse.

#### PAINT, GRAPHICS, AND MARKINGS:

Matson Industrial Floor Grip Non-skid deck coating applied to all walking surfaces. (Color- 223 Gray)

Hull to remain bare aluminum finish. (No Bottom Paint)

Non-reflective vinyl graphics shall be applied. (Specifics to be determined after order has been received)

A U.S. Coast Guard rating placard shall be installed at the dash.

A bow door warning placard shall be installed adjacent to the bow door.

Bow door switch to be mounted on a bow door switch placard.

Secondary bow door switch to be mounted on a bow door switch placard.

#### **PROPULSION:**

A single 250 HP Yamaha four-stroke outboard engine (F250XB) with 25" shaft shall be installed.

Engine comes standard with power trim/tilt and stainless steel propeller. The propeller shall be selected for optimized engine performance.

A Teleflex SeaStar hydraulic steering system shall be installed. Installation includes helm, cylinder, and steering lines.

An engine start bank consisting of two group 27 batteries shall be installed. Batteries are connected by a 4-way selector switch, allowing the engine to be started via either battery or with both batteries in parallel.

Engine shall be installed with mechanical throttle and shift cables, 6YC digital display, singleengine binnacle control, single-engine key switch and emergency shutoff lanyard.

Vessel shall undergo testing (Sea Trials) after completion to verify proper function and performance of all systems.
